Hazing, Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying, Cyber Bullying, Menacing

The Board is committed to providing a positive and productive learning and working environment. Hazing, harassment, intimidation, menacing, cyber bullying, or bullying by students, or third parties is strictly prohibited and shall not be tolerated in the Charter School. This includes actions on school grounds and actions at locations outside of school grounds that can be reasonably expected to materially and substantially interfere with the requirements of appropriate discipline in the operation of the Charter School or impinge on the rights of other students. Such actions are prohibited and those committing them may be subject to disciplinary consequences.

Students whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy will be subject to discipline, up to and including expulsion. Third parties whose behavior is found to be in violation of this policy shall be subject to appropriate sanctions as determined and imposed by Director or Board.

Students or third parties may also be referred to law enforcement officials.

The Director is directed to develop administrative procedures to implement this policy. Procedures shall include descriptions of prohibited conduct; reporting and investigative procedures, as needed; rules for disciplining students who violate this policy; and provisions ensuring notice of this policy is provided to students, teachers, and third parties. The Board shall review this policy annually.
